Wipro through one of its programmes, 'earthian' tries to find solutions to several sustainability issues like climate change, water scarcity, loss of biodiversity, etc. It aims at building skills, attitudes and values to shape a sustainable future and to create an informed society by nurturing sustainability ideas within young minds in schools and colleges.



The Core objectives of Wipro 'earthian' are Integrating Sustainability education into school and college curriculums, to critically engage students with sustainability issues through multiple perspectives, Driving sustainability thinking and action through the learning process and Empowering teachers and learners to drive change in their own contexts and environments.

This year, a team of students from NIST Renewable Energy Club participated in the Wipro Earthian Competition 2015 and has been shortlisted among the top 9 colleges of the country as the Winning Teams for the WIPRO Earthian 2015.

As a part of the competition the students had taken one of the three Sustainability based Cases assigned by WIPRO and worked on it taking Berhampur as the area of operation. The assigned themes were: Waste management/Water management/Mobility in the Urban.

About 2500 Schools and Colleges across India participated in this process out of which only 9 colleges and 14 schools have been shortlisted for the WIPRO EARTHIAN AWARD-2015.
